ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y17-110-DG, Hydraulic Hose Repair, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Bridgestone Hosepower, in the estimated contract award amount of \$335,650, for a 1-year term contract. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew contract for two additional 1-year terms.

PROCUREMENT:

To deliver parts and perform vehicle and/or equipment repairs for Fleet Management Division.

APPROVALS:

The Fleet Management Division and the Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

DISCUSSION

Two bids were received in response to this solicitation and evaluated for responsiveness and responsibility. Zelznak, Inc. dba Pirtek Orlando is deemed non-responsible for failure to meet the scope requirements. The bid from Bridgestone Hosepower is considered reasonable based on the expected future market conditions and information provided by references as to their cost for similar services. Therefore, award is recommended to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Bridgestone Hosepower.
