ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y17-715-MM, Orange County Convention Center North South Building Exterior Electrical, Water & Parking Upgrades, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Allstate Paving, Inc., for the total contract award amount of \$1,574,000 (Alternate Bid), including Additive Bids 1 and 2.

PROCUREMENT:

This scope includes, but is not limited to, supplying the exterior power connections and water connections in the existing parking area and development of overflow parking at the Orange County Convention Center North South Building, to consist of installation of three exterior main electrical services, additional power connections, a water distribution system, paving, storm water drainage structures and an established stand of grass in all effected turf areas. The solicitation provided for an alternate bid to increase the thickness of the asphalt. It was determined that the alternate bid was more cost effective due to the long term durability of the pavement. Additive Bids 1 and 2 include additional electrical provisions in the parking areas. The project is located in District 6.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 4430 035 0965 6310.

The Capital Planning Division and the Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Ten bids were received. The bid received from ONOPA Services, LLC was deemed non-responsible because their references were unable to verify required similar project experience. Allstate Paving, Inc. has a satisfactory performance record per references and County evaluations on record for similar projects. The bid submitted by Allstate Paving, Inc. is considered reasonable based on technical evaluation of staff and the consultant, including the analysis of the third party estimate. Therefore, award is recommended to Allstate Paving, Inc.

The Business Development Division evaluated the 4 lowest bids of the 9 bids submitted for this project and found that the apparent low bidder Allstate Paving, Inc. met the MWBE participation goal and reported 34.50% MWBE participation in their bid. Please note the following certified MWBE participation:

The second low bid submitted by CORE Construction Services of Florida, LLC met the MWBE participation goal and reported 27.42% MWBE participation in their bid.

The third low bid submitted by Wharton-Smith, Inc. met the MWBE participation goal and reported 28.66% MWBE participation in their bid.

The fourth low bid submitted by Jordan Brothers Construction, LLC met the MWBE participation goal and reported 25.01% MWBE participation in their bid.

None of the bids were within the MWBE sliding scale range to be awarded this contract over the low bidder.

Our evaluation of these bids was based on the participation listed on the subcontractor/supplier page. If the low bidder is not chosen, please let us know so that we may obtain Letters of Intent to confirm the participation.
