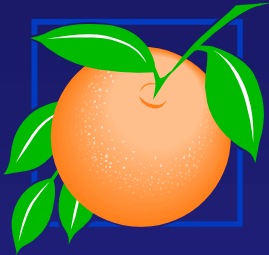

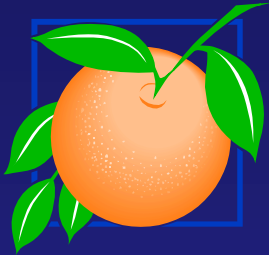

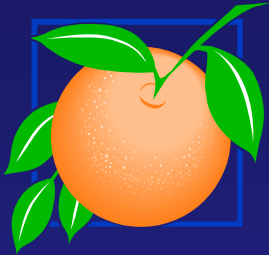
Code Enforcement Board

- **Has jurisdiction to hear and decide alleged violations of the codes and ordinances in force in the county**
- **Has the authority to levy fines against those persons found in non-compliance of county codes**
- **Subject to the inclusion of those professional specialties, each district of the county shall be represented by at least one member. Currently, Districts 1, 2, and 4 are not represented on the board**
- **Meets third Wednesday of each month at 9:00 a.m.**
- **Financial Disclosure Required**



Code Enforcement Board

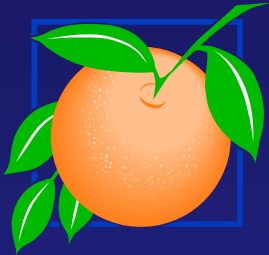
- **Seven members appointed on the basis of experience or interest in the fields of zoning and building control**
- **Shall include, whenever possible:**
 - **An architect**
 - **A business person**
 - **An engineer/surveyor**
 - **A general contractor**
 - **A subcontractor**
 - **A licensed real estate broker or licensed real estate salesman**
- **Term of Rick Mellin has expired and there are three vacancies**



Code Enforcement Board

- **FIRST ACTION REQUESTED:**

Reappointment of Rick J. Mellin, Jr. to the Code Enforcement Board with a term expiring December 31, 2019 or appointment of an individual to succeed him.



Code Enforcement Board

- **SECOND ACTION REQUESTED:**

Appointment of three individuals to the Code Enforcement Board with terms expiring December 31, 2017, December 31, 2018, and December 31, 2019, respectively.
