The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$1,000 from the FY 2017 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purpose:

Contribution:

Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD), Central Florida Chapter. -\$1,000. This organization educates residents living in the Central Florida area about the consequences of driving drunk, educates our youth on the dangers and consequences of underage drinking and offers comfort and support to drunk driving victims. They also provide death notification sensitivity training to law enforcement officers, coroners, and funeral home directors on how to deliver the news of drunk driving fatalities to family members.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$1,000 from the FY 2017 Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide an eligible contribution to Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD), Central Florida Chapter.

PLEASE NOTE:

The Board voted to establish spending limits of 20% for this fund for contributions. At this point in the fiscal year, contributions represent 40% of the total expenditures; however, the restriction applies to total expenditures for the year, at year-end. The Sheriff's Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.
