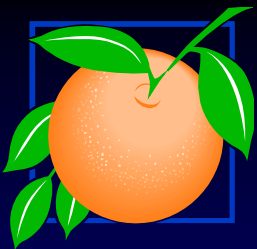




# Purpose

Reentry services are intended to provide meaningful programs that enhance inmate opportunities to become productive citizens upon their return to the community.



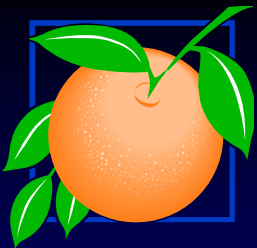


# Purpose

- <5% Department of Corrections

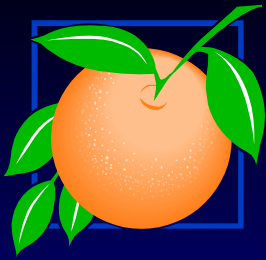

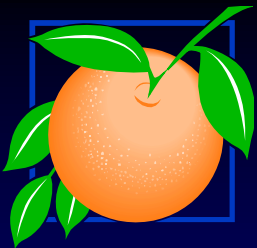
# Reentry Philosophy

**And Extends Beyond Release**



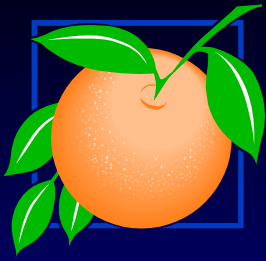

*2014 - 2016*



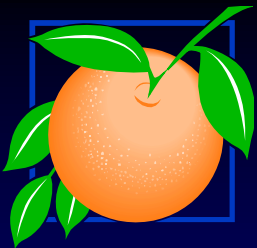

### Changing Criminal Thinking

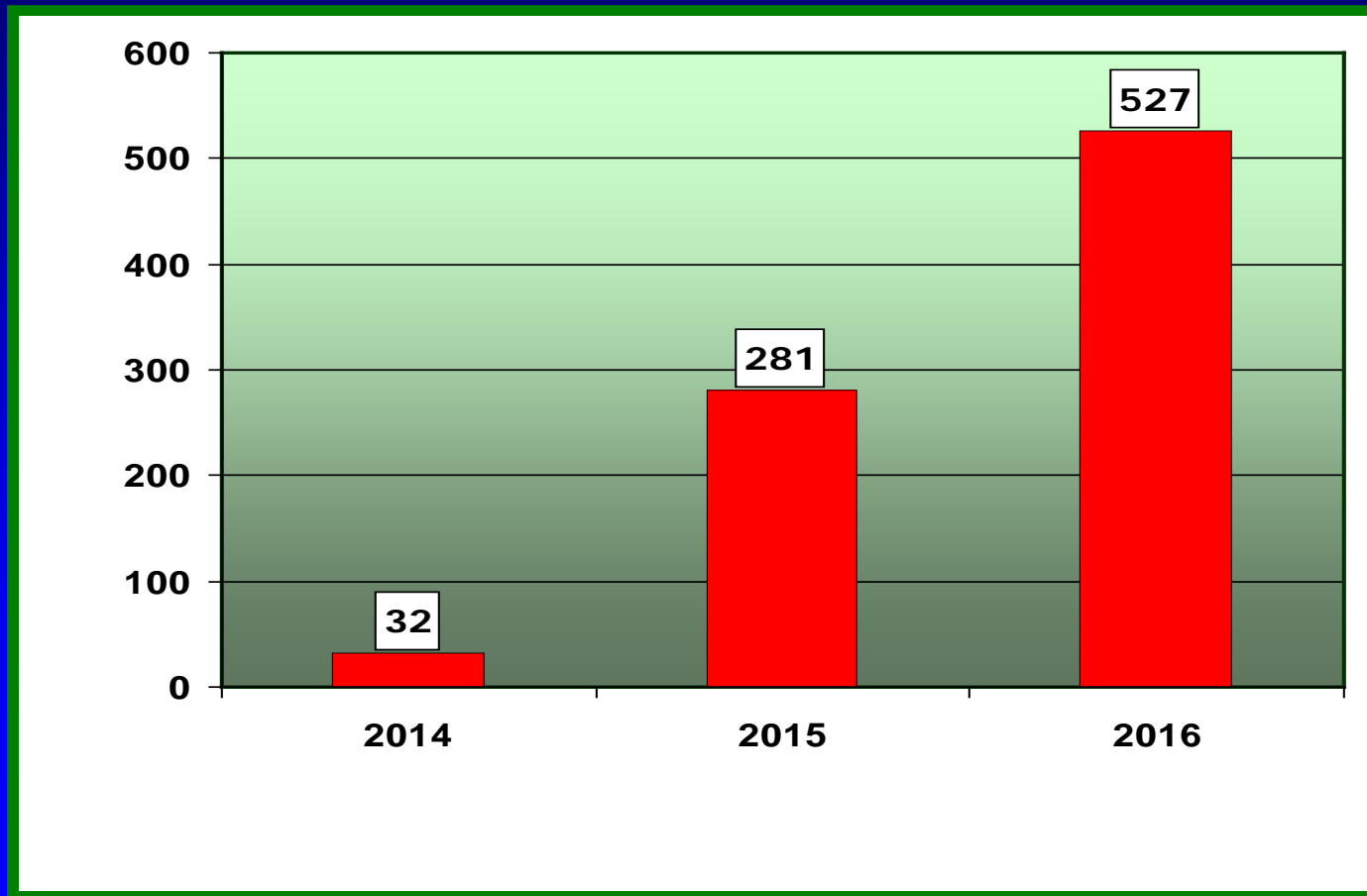


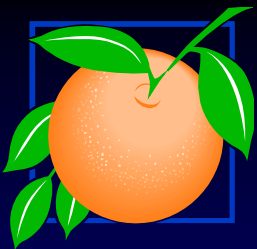

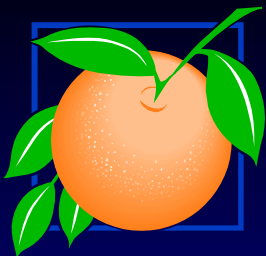




# Summary
