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SUBJ:

Installation of a Traffic Signal at the Intersection of McCulloch Road and

Worchester Drive/Keats Way

The Traffic Engineering staff has conducted a traffic signal warrant study at McCulloch Road and Worchester Drive/Keats Way.

The study consisted of an evaluation of existing field conditions, including delays, sight distance, 24-hour traffic volumes by time of day, traffic thresholds and crash history. For a traffic signal to become warranted, it must meet at least one of the eight traffic signal warrants published in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. The traffic signal warrant analysis shows that conditions were satisfied for Warrant 2 (Four Hour Vehicular Volume) based on existing conditions.

The Traffic Engineering staff recommends that the Board approve the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of McCulloch Road and Worchester Drive/Keats Way.
