The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$24,000 from the FY 2017 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purpose:

**Contributions:**

**National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) – \$1,500.** NAMI is the nation's largest grassroots mental health organization dedicated to building better lives for the millions of Americans affected by mental illness. NAMI advocates for access to services, treatment, supports and research, and is dedicated in its commitment to raise awareness and build a community for hope for all those in need.

**Boy Scouts of America, Central Florida Council - \$7,500.** The Boy Scouts of America's mission is to provide at-risk youth who desperately need guidance and role models with a quality scouting program that will enable them to recognize and reach their full potential by making the right choices to accomplish their goals, to see what they can become through making the right choices, by working hard, and opening their eyes to possibilities of a more constructive lifestyle.

**Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Florida - \$15,000.** This organization provides a compelling alternative to youth crime, gang membership, drugs, and other negative influences that affect our youth today by reaching children at an early age and providing positive activities and encouragement.

**ACTION REQUESTED:** Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$24,000 from the FY 2017 Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide eligible contributions to National Alliance on Mental Illness (\$1,500); Boy Scouts of America, Central Florida Council (\$7,500), and Boys & Girl Clubs of Central Florida (\$15,000).

The Sheriff's Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.

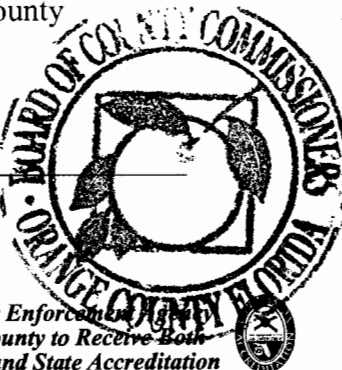




