ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 1, Contract Y17-2040, Intergovernmental Transfer Program (IGT) with Orlando Health, Inc. and Adventist Health System, Inc. d/b/a Florida Hospital in the estimated annual contract \$6,100,000 for a revised total estimated contract amount of \$9,850,123.

PROCUREMENT

The funds will allow for the provision of medical care to the uninsured patients in the county by funding the Primary Care Access Network (PCAN) program.

FUNDING:

The funding for this contract was approved by the Board with Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) on April 11, 2017.

REMARKS

Contract Y17-2040 with Orlando Health, Inc. and Adventist Health System, Inc. d/b/a Florida Hospital was approved by the Board on November 1, 2016 for estimated contract amount of \$3,750,123. The increase of funds will pay for additional services. The IGT program allows the county to draw down additional state and federal dollars for PCAN by participating in the Medicaid Disproportionate Share Hospital (DSH) program and the Medicaid buyback program. Both programs are intended to assist in providing health services to uninsured, underinsured and Medicaid patients.

These funds will be distributed to Orlando Health, Inc. and Adventist Health System, Inc. d/b/a Florida Hospital. The hospitals will use the funds to fund the following PCAN partners:

- Y17-2041 Central Florida Family Health Centers (Primary Care)
- Y17-2042 Community Health Centers (Primary Care)
- Y17-2043 Orange County Dental Research Clinic (Dental)
- Y17-2044 Health Care Center for the Homeless (Primary Care)
- Y17-2045 Shepherd's Hope (Primary Care)
