Orange County Corrections-Campus Wide Boiler System Improvements

#### RECOMMENDATION

Selection of Atkins North America, Inc. to provide Design Services for Corrections-Campus Wide Boiler System Improvements, Request for Proposals Y17-807-RM. Further request the Board authorize the Procurement Division to negotiate and award a contract provided that it does not exceed the budget of \$200,000.

This item was evaluated by the Procurement Committee on February 22, 2017. Commissioner Betsy VanderLey was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

#### **PURPOSE**

To negotiate a contract for the Orange County Corrections-Campus Wide Boiler System Improvements.

#### DISCUSSION

The project is for engineering services for the Orange County Corrections-Campus Wide Boiler System Improvements. The existing boiler system is a decentralized system with individual boilers at every building. The corrections campus is currently served by nine boilers. The project will address the lack of boiler redundancy in the existing system and provide a solution based on best practices in the industry that provide increased efficiencies and reduced energy, maintenance, and operation costs.

The consultant will perform the following services:

- 1. Schematic Design
- 2. Design Development
- 3. Construction Contract Documents
- 4. Permit Services
- 5. Contract Administration

Two proposals were received in response to the solicitation. The proposal submitted by Moses & Associates, Inc. failed to meet the minimum scoring required to be considered for award.
