1965

Orange County established Air and Water
 Pollution Control Act

1985

DEP designated EPD as a "locally approved air program" and authorized funding

1989

- General Operating Agreement (GOA)
 delineated each agency's authorities
- GOA Delegates the duties and responsibilities by a Specific Operating Agreement (SOA)





- Specific Operating Agreement (SOA)
 - Outlines air program duties & responsibilities
 - Air Program Management
 - Permitting
 - Compliance & Enforcement
 - Ambient Air Monitoring
 - Data Management
 - Renewed every three years
 - Requires ordinance to be current with DEP rules





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- Staff reviewed EPA's National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAPs) and the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) relevant to the air ordinance
- Minor changes incorporated:

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- F.A.C 62-4 Permits
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F.A.C 62-204 Air Pollution Control

F.A.C. 62-210 Stationary Sources

F.A.C 62-296 Stationary Sources-Emission Standards

F.A.C 62-297 Stationary Sources-Emission Monitoring



Ordinance Review

- February 22, 2017
 - Environmental Protection Commission voted to support proposed revisions and to move forward to BCC for adoption
- March 29, 2017
 - Stakeholders meeting
- Ordinance revisions are not expected to substantially impact development of real property within the County



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- Determine that proposed Ordinance will not have a substantial impact on the development of real property within Orange County.
- Adopt the Ordinance amending Chapter 15,
 Article III. Air Quality Control.
