## **ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y17-1024-MV, Cleaning and Pumping of Stormwater Sediment Removal Structures to the low responsive and responsible bidder, EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc. in the estimated contract award amount of \$201,000.06 for a 3-year term. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for two additional 1-year terms.

# PROCUREMENT:

Stormwater sediment removal structures assist in preserving and managing the County's lake system water quality by trapping typical roadway litter, i.e. leaves, wrappers, cigarette butts, dirt, sand, etc.

#### **FUNDING**:

Funds are available in account number 0001 068 2422 3197. Additional funding will come from various lake taxing units.

# **APPROVALS:**

The Environmental Protection and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation.

#### REMARKS:

Three bids were received in response to Invitation for Bids Y17-1024-MV, and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility and price. The low bidder, EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc. has a satisfactory record of performance with the County and has been deemed responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to EnviroWaste Services Group, Inc.
