On Nov. 29, 2016, the BCC reviewed CFHLA's proposal to amend Chapter 4 of the Orange County Code to extend the hours of operation for sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages in various places including hotels, motels and restaurants.



Section 4-3 of Orange County Code:

- Permits on premise sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages from 11 a.m.- 2 a.m. of following day
- Exceptions:
 - -Golf course may serve 7 a.m. to sundown
 - -Private function at banquet hall or convention facility with minimum 10,000 sq.ft. may serve 7 a.m.-3 a.m.
 - Hotel and motel may serve 7 a.m. 3 a.m. at private hotel guest rooms

Key Changes Proposed to 11 a.m. – 2 a.m. Hours in Section 4-3:

Amend subsection (a)(3) to allow sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages at any place inside a hotel or motel from 7 a.m. – 2 a.m. and continue to allow sale and service at private guest rooms until 3 a.m.

Add subsection (a)(4) to allow sale and consumption at food service establishments from 7 a.m. – 2 a.m.
