SUBJECT: Selection of Consultant, Request for Proposals Y17-1011-LC, Third
Party Claim Administration and Managed Care Services

RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of one firm and an alternate, to provide Third Party Claim Administration and Managed Care Services, under Request for Proposals Y17-1011-LC, from the two firms listed below in alphabetical order.

Cannon Cochran Management Services, Inc.
York Risk Services Group, Inc.

Further request authority for the Procurement Division to negotiate and execute a 3-year contact within a budget amount of \$5,706,936, renewable for two additional 1-year terms. This item was evaluated by the Procurement Committee on May 3, 2017. Commissioner Jennifer Thompson was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PURPOSE

The contractor will assume the administration of all claims, closed and open, and provide related technical assistance to the County; act as service provider representative on any claim issues or problems; act as liaison among the insurer, adjusters, field staff, medical management providers, medical network, the Risk Management Information System and the County.

DISCUSSION:

The County originally implemented its property and casualty self-insurance program on March 15, 1977. Current participants include the Board of County Commissioners, Clerk of Courts, Comptroller, Property Appraiser, Supervisor of

Elections and Tax Collector. The contractor will administer claims involving workers compensation, general liability, automobile liability, environmental liability, property and crime bond/employee dishonesty. The Risk Management Division administers these programs with oversight from the Risk Management Committee.

Seven proposals were received in response to RFP Y17-1011-LC. The proposals of USIS, Inc, TRISTAR Risk Enterprise Management, Inc., CorVel Enterprise Comp., Inc., and Gallagher Bassett Services, Inc. scored too low for Board consideration. North American Risk Services, Inc. was deemed non-responsive because their Fee Schedule Form deviated from the required units of measure on lines 8-10, and they qualified their bid on lines 12-14.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals against the stated criteria.

Attached are the consensus scores.
