SUBJECT: June 6, 2017 – Consent Item Memorandum of Understanding regarding Warren Park

The Parks and Recreation Division is requesting the Board of County Commissioners approve the Memorandum of Understanding between Orange County, Florida, the Orange County Sheriff's Office, and the City of Belle Isle regarding Warren Park.

Orange County's Warren Park is located on Lake Conway within the City limits of Belle Isle. The Parks and Recreation Division submitted a Site Plan Application to the City to construct a Canoe and Kayak Launch at Warren Park. As a condition of approval, the City of Belle Isle has asked the parties to establish clear lines of responsibility for law enforcement response to calls for service at the Park. This agreement establishes that the City of Belle Isle Police Department will be dispatched first to calls for service at Warren Park.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval and execution of Memorandum of Understanding between Orange County, Florida and Office of the Orange County Sheriff and City of Belle Isle regarding Warren Park and authorization for the County Mayor or designee to approve any amendments to this contract. District 3

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA AND OFFICE OF THE ORANGE COUNTY SHERIFF AND CITY OF BELLE ISLE

This **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** (herein referred to as the "MOU") is made and entered into as of this **6th day of June, 2017**, by and among **ORANGE COUNTY**, **FLORIDA**, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida (herein referred to as the "County") and the **OFFICE OF THE ORANGE COUNTY SHERIFF**, an independently elected and serving constitutional officer (herein referred to as the "Sheriff") and the **CITY OF BELLE ISLE** (herein referred to as the "City").

RECITALS

Whereas, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners has established a County Park named "Warren Park," within the city limits of Belle Isle, Florida; and

Whereas, the parties acknowledge that both the City of Belle Isle and the Orange County Sheriff's Office have concurrent jurisdiction over the park and its facilities; and

Whereas, the Orange County Sheriff's Office currently provides 911 Communications services to the City of Belle Isle; and

Whereas, the City of Belle Isle has asked the parties to establish clear lines of responsibility for calls for service originating within Warren Park, as a condition of approval of Orange County's site plan application for a canoe and kayak launch in Warren Park; and

Whereas, this MOU is intended to fulfill the aforementioned condition of approval appended by the City of Belle Isle to its conditional approval of Orange County's application at the City's regular City Council meeting on March 21, 2017.

NOW THEREFORE; the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Orange County Sheriff's Office will dispatch members of the Belle Isle Police Department to calls for service originating from Warren Park.
- 2. In the event that the Belle Isle Police Department is not able to immediately respond due to the volume of calls for service or other emergencies affecting staffing levels; the Orange County Sheriff's Office will respond, in accordance with Sheriff's Office protocols; personnel permitting.
- 3. The parties acknowledge that enforcement of certain ordinances related to County Parks may only be enforced as provided for within the Orange County Code.
- 4. This MOU shall be effective the day, month and year first written above.
