Project

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y17-754-EB, Hansel Pond Improvements Project, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Gregori Construction, Inc., in the estimated contract award amount of \$1,031,494.

PROCUREMENT:

This scope of the project includes, but is not limited to, dredging of excess sediment material from the pond; deepening the pond shelf around the outfall structure and the main portion of the pond; replacing the existing V-notch weir with a bleed down orifice; securing the existing outfall trash racks; installing a new angled skimmer to direct trash to the southern pond bank; installing limerock stabilization material at the southwest and southeast corners of the project site; installing a new 54-inch inflow pipe with associated manhole and mitered end section; installing a steel sheet pile wall to extend along the western and southern banks of the pond; and installation of articulated concrete block for side bank stabilization of pond slopes. The project is located in District 3.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1023-072-2753-6330.

<u>APPROVALS:</u>

The Stormwater Management Division and Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Five bids were received. The bid submitted by Custom Built Marine Construction, Inc. was allowed to be withdrawn due to a mistake in bid.

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Award of Invitation for Bids Y17-754-EB

The low bid submitted by Gregori Construction, Inc. is approximately 12% lower than the second low bid. Staff attributed the price difference to current market fluctuations and contractor's means and methods. Gregori Construction, Inc. has a satisfactory record of performance and has been determined responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to Gregori Construction, Inc.

The Business Development Division evaluated the 4 bids submitted for this project and found that the apparent low bidder Gregori Construction, Inc. met the MWBE participation goal and reported 27.78% MWBE participation in their bid. Please note the following certified MWBE participation:

The second low bid submitted by Gibbs & Register, Inc. met the MWBE participation goal and reported 26.35% MWBE participation in their bid.

The third low bid submitted by Pac Comm, Inc. did not achieve good faith effort documentation and reported 1.47% MWBE participation in their bid.

The fourth low bid submitted by Cathcart Construction Company-Florida did not achieve good faith effort documentation and reported 18.40% MWBE participation in their bid.

None of the bids were within the MWBE sliding scale range to be awarded this contract over the low bidder.

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Our evaluation of these bids was based on the participation listed on the subcontractor/supplier page. If the low bidder is not chosen, please let us know so that we may obtain Letters of Intent to confirm the participation.

Attached is a spreadsheet reconciling the bidders' compliance with the IFB's M/WBE requirements, including the percentage breakdown for all bidders and a comparison of the relative bids versus participation percentages.
