July 2017 Neighborhood Pride Capital Improvement Grant

Recipient

The Neighborhood Preservation and Revitalization Division administers the Neighborhood Pride Grant Program that provides funds for citizen organizations to enhance the quality of their neighborhoods. The Neighborhood Pride Grants are available countywide in amounts ranging between \$1,500 to \$10,000. Neighborhood Pride Grant applications are accepted year-round and are reviewed monthly by the Neighborhood Grants Advisory Board (NGAB).

The NGAB is recommending approval of one capital improvement grant for Reflections at Spring Lake HOA to pressure wash walls, install lighting and replace tile and sign letters. (See Attachment A). The grant request is displayed in greater detail in Attachment B. The grant request was reviewed and scored by Orange County staff and presented to the NGAB for recommendation. The application was reviewed based on project feasibility, organizational readiness, and benefit to the community. In addition, the application was reviewed against the County's permitting requirements to ensure that the project would comply with appropriate County codes. Finally, the organization was required to document the appropriate cash match and demonstrate an ability to maintain the project.
