

#### GENERAL REQUIREMENT:

Solid Waste Management Facilities in Orange County shall be permitted pursuant to Orange County Code Chapter 32, Article V, the "Solid Waste Management Ordinance." Applications for permits to construct, operate, close and conduct post-closure care of these facilities and ancillary operations shall be made at the Environmental Protection Division (EPD) office.

#### **GENERAL PROCEDURE:**

Submit a complete application that meets the requirements of Orange County Code Chapter 32, Article V. EPD will review the application and request additional information if necessary to complete the application and have enough information to make a recommendation. For facilities within unincorporated Orange County, review by the Development Review Committee [32-214(a)(2)] and by the Board of Zoning Adjustment for a Special Exception [32-214(a)(3)] are also required. A decision on the EPD permit application, and the Special Exception if applicable, will then be made by the Board of County Commissioners at a concurrent public hearing. [32-214(j)]

For permit renewals, EPD will review the application, determine a recommendation, and then schedule on the agenda for the Board of County Commissioners for a decision. [32-214(n)]



  - b) Provide a Landscape Buffer Plan that meets the requirements of O.C.C. 32-216(a)(11)d. and Chapter 24. [O.C.C. 32-215(a)(5)h.]
  - c) Delineate any environmentally sensitive areas such as any conservation areas, the Wekiva Study Area, and areas protected by the Wevika River Protection Area Ordinance or the Econolockhatchee River Protection Ordinance. [O.C.C. 32-215(a)(5)i.]
- 3. Provide a description of the operation and functions of all processing equipment that will be used, with design criteria and expected performance. The description shall show the flow of solid waste and associated operations in detail, and shall include (Rule 62-701.710(2)(c), F.A.C.):
  - a) Regular facility operations as they are expected to occur;
  - b) Procedures for start up operations, and scheduled and unscheduled shut down operations; and
  - Potential safety hazards and control methods, including fire detection and control.

- Provide a boundary survey, legal description, and topographic survey of the property (Rule 62-701.710(2)(g), F.A.C.).
  - Note: A topographic survey is required per F.A.C. 62-701.710(2)g. but as it is excluded in O.C.C. 32-215(f)(2), the additional criteria for the survey in 32-215(a)(2) will not apply.
- 8. Provide a description of the design requirements for the facility which demonstrate how the applicant will comply with Rule 62-701.710(3), F.A.C.
  - a) Access to the sites shall be controlled via installation of a security chain link fence. [O.C.C. 32-216 (a)(13); Section 38-1408.]
  - b) Provide a Litter Control Plan for the facility. [O.C.C. 32-215(a)(15)]

- c) Truck scales shall be calibrated, as a minimum, every twelve (12) months and the certificate of calibration shall be displayed at the scale house or gate house at all times.
- 9. Provide an operation plan which describes how the applicant will comply with Rule 62-701.710(4), F.A.C. (Rule 62-701.710(2)(h), F.A.C.).
  - a) Provide a Fire Fighting Agreement that has been approved by the local Fire Rescue service provider. [O.C.C. 32-215(a)(21)]
- 10. Provide a closure plan which describes generally how the applicant will comply with Rule 62-701.710(6), F.A.C. (Rule 62-701.710(2)(i). F.A.C.).
- 11. Unless exempted by Rule 62-701.710(10)(a), F.A.C., provide the financial assurance documentation required by Rule 62-701.710(7), F.A.C. (Rule 62-701.710(2)(j), F.A.C.).
  - Note: O.C.C. 32-216 (a)(27) requires financial assurance regardless of first-in first-out waste management. In the cost estimate include funds for up to 180 days of miscellaneous site maintenance (e.g. landscape and site access control).
- 12. Provide documentation to show that stormwater will be controlled according to the requirements of Rule 62-701.710(8), F.A.C.
  - Note: The stormwater requirements of O.C.C. 32-216(b)(6) must also be met.
- 13. Provide documentation to show that the applicant will comply with the recordkeeping requirements of Rule 62-701.710(9), F.A.C.
