Establishment of an All-Way "Stop" Condition at the Intersection of Tanja

King Boulevard and Honey Locust Drive/Peppervine Drive

At the request of the District 4 Commissioner, the Traffic Engineering staff has evaluated the need for an all-way "Stop" condition at the intersection of Tanja King Boulevard and Honey Locust Drive/Peppervine Drive.

A study by the Traffic Engineering Division determined that traffic patterns have changed since the opening of the new Avalon Park Community Center. This intersection was found to meet the minimum 8-hour traffic volumes required for installation of an all-way stop condition.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the installation of an all-way "Stop" condition at the intersection of Tanja King Boulevard and Honey Locust Drive/Peppervine Drive.


