SUBJECT:	Award of Invitation for Bids Y17-1104-LC, Grease Trap, Lift Station and Septic Systems Preventative Maintenance and Repair

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y17-1104-LC, Grease Trap, Lift Station and Septic Systems Preventative Maintenance and Repair, to the low responsive and responsible bidders, Brownie's Septic and Plumbing, LLC for Lot A in the estimated annual contract amount of \$186,784 and Lapin Septic Tank Services, Inc. for Lot B in the estimated annual contract amount of \$266,645. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for two additional 1-year terms.

PROCUREMENT:

The work includes preventative maintenance and inspections for commercial grade grease traps, lift stations, and septic systems and proper operation of these systems and their components, including, but not limit to, dosing systems, distribution boxes, drain fields, pumps, and transmission line.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account numbers 001-043-1713-3180, 001-043-1715-3180, 001-043-1717-3180, 001-043-1718-3180 and 001-043-1719-3180.

APPOVALS:

The Facilities Management Division and Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Brownie's Septic and Plumbing, LLC and Lapin Septic Tanks Services, Inc. have satisfactory performance records on similar projects and their bids are considered reasonable compared to previous contract pricing.
