

- Operating since 2002 under FDEP permit
- Transfers Class I, Class III, and construction and demolition debris waste
- Applying to comply with code changes that brought in facilities in municipalities
- EPD reviewed for requirements in Chapter 32
 Article V (Solid Waste Management Ordinance)



Location Map



Code requirements

- 1. Hours of Operation7 am 7 pm
- Landscaping with perimeter trees, grassed areas, etc.
- Spotter inspection and detailed inspection of 3 random loads each week

Waiver requests

Continue with 24 hours per day

Existing landscaping in accordance with City of Orlando

Spotter inspection but no detailed inspections as waste is inspected at destination facilities



Throughput rate updated

- -1,000 tons per day avg.
 - \rightarrow 3,000 tons per day max.
- -fits within existing capacity
- -consistent with existing State FDEP permit



Approval for five (5) years of the Solid Waste Management Facility – Transfer Station – Permit Application, for the Orlando Transfer Station, by Waste Management Inc. of Florida, with Waivers and Conditions. District 6
