Shelters

- 14 school shelters opened 39 deputies assigned for security.
- 24 deputies assigned to county shelters.
- Central Operations 45 deputies along with 56 family members and eight animals sought shelter.
- Each sector also had employees and family members seeking shelter.



Calls for Service September 9-14, 2017


- Total Felony Arrests 223
- Total Misdemeanor Arrests 244
- Total Curfew Arrests 37
- Total Calls for Service 24, 909
- Average daily CFS 4,151
- Average daily CFS for 2016 3,063
- **35.5%** Increase calls for service during the time of the hurricane.

Significant Events

- Three people died as a result of apparent carbon monoxide poisoning from a generator at a home in the 5600 block of Eggleston Avenue.
- During the curfew hours, the Orange County Sheriff's Office made four arrests for commercial burglary and two residential burglary arrests during a state of emergency. These calls were originally reported as "looting."

Significant Challenges

- Traffic control issues related to power outages.
- Two Orange County radio towers were reported out of service, affecting the downtown and Lake Buena Vista areas.
