SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment No. 3, Contract Y16-2054, Prenatal Care

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 3, Contract Y16-2054, Prenatal Care with the Florida Department of Health Orange County, in the amount of \$100,000, for a revised total annual contract amount of \$380,000.

PROCUREMENT:

Additional funding is needed due to increased utilization. The program provides comprehensive prenatal care designed to identify patients who are pregnant, encourage early and ongoing prenatal care, and increase patient's access to prenatal information. This program targets uninsured, underinsured and medically indigent residents of Orange County.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 0001-060-2502-3167.

APPROVALS:

The Health Services Department concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

The program includes services typically provided by an obstetrics practice in the local medical community. Prenatal care is to be delivered in an obstetric clinic and will be provided by a licensed obstetrician/nurse practitioner/nurse midwife. Also, case management will be provided to patients identified with high-risk pregnancies. A risk appraisal for pregnant women will be completed for all pregnant patients.

Contract Y16-2054 with the Florida Department of Health Orange County was approved by the Board on October 6, 2015 and awarded for an estimated contract amount of \$280,000.

Amendment No. 1 renewed the contract performance period from October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.

Amendment No. 2 renewed the contract performance period from October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018.
