# **ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y18-106-LC, Furnish Asphalt Products, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Middlesex Asphalt, LLC, in the estimated contract award amount of \$2,146,500 for a 1-year term. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for two additional 1-year terms.

### PROCUREMENT:

Asphalt products for Roads and Drainage Division as required for supporting roadway maintenance and construction.

#### **FUNDING:**

Funding is available in account number 1004-072-2990-4160.

### **APPROVALS:**

The Roads and Drainage Division and the Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

## **REMARKS:**

Two bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids. The bid from Ranger Construction Industries, Inc was deemed non-responsive due to failure to bid on all lines for Lot A.

The estimated contract amount includes every conceivable requirement that may materialize during performance, while the total estimated number or orders against the contract are based on the needs and budgetary limitations.

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Although the price of the bid is 7.5% higher than the engineering estimate and 20% higher than the previous contract, the proposed prices are considered reasonable based on market fluctuations over time.
