ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y17-1094-MV, Water Meter Testing, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Taylor Meter Technologies, in the estimated contract award amount of \$361,371 for a 3-year term. Further, request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for two additional 1-year terms.

PROCUREMENT:

To provide water meter testing services throughout the County for the Utilities Department.

FUNDING:

Funding will be available in account 4420 038 1328 3197.

APPROVALS:

The Field Services and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Two bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility and price reasonableness. The low bidder, Taylor Meter Technologies, has the necessary manpower and equipment to perform this contract.

Staff has determined the bid prices of Taylor Meter Technologies are reasonable, based on comparison to current Manatee County contract prices. The low bidder, Taylor Meter Technologies, meets all specifications and other requirements of the solicitation. Therefore, recommendation for award is made to Taylor Meter Technologies.
