**Advisory Council's Recommendations:** 

29 Cultural Tourism projects: \$2,679,650



2 Blockbuster projects: \$400,000



- Hurricane Irma relief: \$300,000
  - Staff directed to return on October 31,
    2017 and present how this program would be administered.



### **Hurricane Irma**

- 15 arts organizations reported hurricane losses of \$420,580.
- Original proposal was to provide up to \$300,000 to reimburse some of these losses.
- Losses would have been verified.
- Expenditure reimbursement only for statutorily allowed uses of TDT.

# Arts & Cultural Affairs

- Staff reviewed proposal based on Board's feedback and determined:
  - Program would be administratively cumbersome:
    - Verifying capital and operating losses.
    - Checking for insurance and FEMA coverage.
    - Ensuring legal TDT eligibility.
- Based on this review, staff developed an alternative option.



#### **Alternative Option**

- Add 50% 60% of reported hurricane damage and losses to existing Cultural Tourism program.
  - Added funds to be utilized for already approved upcoming events.
  - Funds will help ensure success of events.
  - These funds are already set aside for arts and cultural affairs.
  - Allows arts organizations to use their own funds for Hurricane Irma losses.
- Arts and Cultural Affairs Advisory Council recommends 60% level or \$252,348.



Approval of awards to eligible arts organizations and authorization to disbursed \$252,348 of supplemental funding from the approved Blockbuster reserve funds to be applied toward upcoming events as recommended by the Arts and **Cultural Affairs Advisory Council.**
