Approval and Execution of Resolution of the Orange County Board of County Commissioners Regarding Establishing Fees For The Non-

Motorized Vehicles-For-Hire Ordinance

I. BACKGROUND:

On October 17, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance No. 2017-17, related to the regulation of non-motorized vehicles-for-hire (a/k/a "pedicabs") in the International Drive Master Transit and Improvement District.

Among other things, the Ordinance requires that all pedicabs be issued a decal in order to operate within the District. As part of the decal application process, each pedicab will undergo an inspection for compliance with the Ordinance's vehicle safety and equipment standards. Additionally, all pedicab drivers operating within the District are required to apply for a driver's permit and undergo a criminal background check. The proposed fees are intended to cover the administrative costs to process applications, conduct background checks, and inspect pedicabs, as well as the actual costs of the decals and permits.

The Ordinance provides that decal and driver's permit fees are to be established by Resolution of the Board. The subject Resolution establishes a \$125.00 decal fee; a \$55.00 driver's permit fee; and a \$10.00 replacement driver's permit fee.

Permitting is expected to begin in December in anticipation of the Ordinance becoming effective on January 1, 2018.
