### **Current Regulations**

- Section 38-1414 of the Code requires 5000 feet separation between package liquor stores regardless of the jurisdiction
- Section 38-1414 provides that distance be measured from the main entrance of the proposed package store to the main entrance of existing package store by following the shortest route of ordinary pedestrian travel along public thoroughfare



### **Current Regulations**

■ Section 38-1415 requires 1000 ft. separation from the proposed package store to school, and provides that distance is measured from the main entrance of the proposed package store to main entrance door of the school



### **State Lottery for Quota Licenses**

- Each year the State of Florida holds a lottery drawing for new quota licenses.
- For every 7,500 people residing in the county according to the census bureau, one quota license may be issued.





### **Previous Work Session**

### Reduces the 5000 ft separation as follows:


- New Licenses
  - 2500 ft. from all quota license locations
- Existing Licenses\*
  - 1250 ft. from all quota license locations
- Reciprocity
  - 750 ft. from quota license locations in the municipal limits
- \* defined as those located, licensed and established at the time of the adoption of the ordinance



### **Proposed Amendments**

- Section 38-1414
  - Reduces the 5000 ft. separation requirement to 3500 ft. for package stores in unincorporated area
  - States that a package store in unincorporated area shall be no closer than
    750 ft. from a package store in a municipality

### **Proposed Amendments**

### Section 38-1415

-The distance from a package sale vendor's location to a school shall be measured from the main entrance of proposed package store to any entrance to the school property that is used by students.



### **Recommended Ordinance**

- Draft Ordinance prepared consistent with BCC direction
- Held Community Meeting with the stakeholders in August 2017
  - -The majority of stakeholders opposed any reduction in the separation requirement
- Public hearing with the Planning and Zoning Commission October 2017
  - -2500 ft/1250 ft. changed to 3500 ft.
  - -PZC recommended approval of the ordinance (7-1)



### **Requested Action**

Adopt an ordinance affecting the use of land in Orange County, Florida, regarding the sale of alcoholic beverages; amending Section 38-1414 of the Orange County Code relating to prohibited areas for the sale of alcoholic beverages; amending Section 38-1415 of the **Orange County Code relating to distances between** places selling alcoholic beverages and religious institutions, schools and adult entertainment establishments; and providing an effective date
