FY 2018 Law Enforcement Trust Fund Expenditure

Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$11,000 from the FY 2018 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purpose:

Contributions:

National Latino Peace Officers Association, Central Florida Chapter -\$1,000. This charitable organization is comprised of law enforcement officers and civilian personnel from different agencies in the Central Florida area. The organization's primary dedication to the community is to provide children and young adults with educational and community service opportunities. Each year, this organization sponsors a "Three Kings Day Celebration" that distributes toys to under-privileged children from under-privileged families. These children are selected from referrals submitted by school resource officers, children advocate groups, and local ministries. This also gives the children the opportunity to interact with law enforcement officers in a positive manner.

Orange County Police Athletic League (PAL) - \$10,000. This organization is a juvenile crime prevention program that provides athletic, recreational, and educational activities to at-risk children. PAL allows a law enforcement officer to spend time with these children in the role of coach, mentor, instructor, and role model, encouraging them to avoid crime, drugs, gangs, and violence.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$11,000 from the FY 2018 Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide eligible contributions to the National Latino Peace Officers Association, Central Florida Chapter (\$1,000), and the Orange County Police Athletic League (PAL) (\$10,000).

The Sheriff's Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.
