 Establishment of a Burn Ban
 Adoption of the 6<sup>th</sup> Edition of the Florida Fire Prevention Code
 Action Requested





 Automatic Activation Upon Keetch Byram Drought Index (KBDI) Reaches 500
 Automatically Deactivates when KBDI is Below 500 for 7 Consecutive Days
 Consistent with Surrounding Counties



- If the violator's action do not cause a fire:
  - 1. Prosecute as misdemeanor. Up to 60 days in prison and/or \$500 fine; and/or
  - 2. Cite under Section 11, Orange County Code. Civil penalty up to \$500.
- If the violator's actions do cause a fire:
  - 1. Prosecute as misdemeanor. Up to 60 days in prison and/or \$500 fine; and/or
  - Issue Notice of Violation under Section 11, Orange County Code for an irreversible/irreparable violation. One time penalty up to \$15,000.
