SUBJECT: First Responders, Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration & Center for Substance Abuse Prevention Grant
Consent Agenda – February 20, 2018

The US Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration and the Center for Substance Abuse Prevention awarded Orange County the First Responders, Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act (CARA) grant in the amount of \$500,000 a year for four years. The funding will be utilized to work with local law enforcement agencies to purchase naloxone and provide training for staff, work with Orlando Health and Florida Hospital's busiest emergency departments to establish processes and protocols for appropriate referral to treatment for suspected opioid/heroin overdoses and work with the Florida Department of Health, Orange County on data collection and evaluation. In addition, the grant funds will provide local substance abuse treatment providers, healthcare providers, Orange County Corrections, Orange County Public Schools, United Way and other key community sectors with naloxone training and resources. Orange County was one of 21 agencies selected in the nation to receive the grant and the only award in the state of Florida.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of Notice of Award Grant Number: 6H79SP080299-01M001 between the US Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, Center for Substance Abuse Prevention and Orange County for the Orange County First Responders-CARA Grant in the amount of \$500,000 and authorization to accept future notice of awards during this four-year grant cycle.
