### RECOMMENDATION

Selection of four firms and an alternate to provide Continuing Professional Engineering Stormwater Management Services, Request for Proposals Y18-900-EB, from the following firms listed alphabetically. Further recommend the Board authorize execution of the final contracts by the Procurement Division to establish hourly rates for future requirements for a one-year term with two 1-year renewals.

DeLoach Engineering Science, PLLC
Geosyntec Consultants, Inc.
Inwood Consulting Engineers, Inc.
Singhofen & Associates, Inc.

This item was evaluated by the Procurement Committee on February 7, 2018. Commissioner Victoria P. Siplin was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

## **PURPOSE**

To provide continuing stormwater management engineering services to support the Stormwater Management and Roads and Drainage Divisions' projects throughout the County.

### **DISCUSSION**

The consultants will provide engineering services for drainage improvement projects. Services may include, but are not limited to, stormwater management analysis, surveys, design work, plan preparations, permitting, and construction administration. Currently, there are four continuing contracts in place for stormwater management engineering services. Staff anticipates that four contracts will be required to meet the projected demand for these services.

To remain consistent with the Board's policy to ensure equitable distribution of work, these contracts will be monitored to ensure a reasonable degree of evenness in the distribution of contract dollars. There will be, however, occasions when the continued use of a particular consultant is necessary which may impact the distribution of contract dollars. These situations include the following:

- Continuation of services initially performed by a particular consultant.
- Services for which a particular consultant is uniquely qualified to provide.
- Difficulty in obtaining proposals from other consultants.
- Difficulty in negotiating task authorizations with other consultants.
- Other justified reasons.

A protest was submitted by DeLoach Engineering Science, Inc. The Procurement Committee heard the protest and upheld the original scores, therefore denying the protest.
