Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y18-749-RM, East Orange Head Start Modular Relocation, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Café Construction & Development, Inc. in the total contract award amount of \$229,500.

Work consists of relocating the modular building at the East Orange Park. The project is located in District 5.

Two bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and Café Construction & Development, Inc. has been determined to be responsible. The Business Development Division evaluated the 2 lowest bids submitted for this project and found that the apparent low bidder Orange County MWBE firm Café Construction & Development, Inc. is bidding as a prime. Therefore, Café Construction & Development, Inc. is required to self- perform no less than 51% of the contract per Sec. 17-321 in the MWBE Ordinance. In the event this requirement is not achieved, then other MWBE's will have to be included to achieve the 25% MWBE goal. Café Construction & Development, Inc. reported self-performing 61.87%. They reported 14.24% other MWBE participation in their bid and met the MWBE participation goal. Please note the following certified MWBE participation:

The second low bid submitted by Orange County MWBE firm Regis Southern, Inc. is bidding as a prime. Therefore, Regis Southern, Inc. is required to self- perform no less than 51% of the contract per Sec. 17-321 in the MWBE Ordinance. In the event this requirement is not achieved, then other MWBE's will have to be included to achieve the 25% MWBE goal. Regis Southern, Inc. reported self-performing 51.07%. They reported 0% other MWBE participation in their bid and met the MWBE participation goal.

None of the bids met the MWBE sliding scale range criteria to be awarded this contract over the low bidder.

Our evaluation of these bids was based on the participation listed on the subcontractor/supplier page. If the low bidder is not chosen, please let us know so that we may obtain Letters of Intent to confirm the participation.
