The Community Action Board (CAB) is responsible for development, review, supervision, evaluation, and making recommendations for final approval of all fiscal and program policies, plans, priorities, proposals, budgets, and any other activities to be conducted by the Community Action Division. The CAB consists of three sectors: public sector, private sector, and low income community sector.

The Board of County Commissioners appoints the eight members of the public sector, which is composed of up to three County Commissioners, up to three elected officials from three different municipalities located in Orange County, up to two members representing the state of Florida or United States Congress, and one member of the Orange County School Board. Currently, there is one vacancy on the board due to the departure of Commissioner Nelson, as noted on the attached chart.

On May 22, 2018, the Board will be asked to appoint one commissioner to the CAB with a term expiring December 31, 2019.
