SUBJ: Installation of a "No Parking" zone on both sides of Ficquette Road from  
Ingelnook Drive to 700 feet South of New Independence Parkway

The Traffic Engineering Division has determined that the parking of vehicles along Ficquette Road for sporting and community events at Deputy Scott Pine Community Park is creating a hazardous condition to vehicles traveling on Ficquette Road.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the establishment of a "No Parking" zone on the east and west sides of Ficquette Road from Ingelnook Drive to 700 feet south of New Independence Parkway to improve safety.

**Action Requested:** Approval of a "No Parking" zone installation on both sides of Ficquette Road from Ingelnook Drive to 700 feet south of New Independence Parkway. District 1.
