

- City Annexations (1990-1995)










- Agreement Background
 - Section 335.0415, Florida Statutes Public Roads May be Transferred Between Jurisdictions Only by Mutual Agreement of the Affected Governmental Entities







- Agreement Background
- August 13, 2018 Maitland City Council Approved Transfer Agreement
 - Key Provision
 - Unless having first applied for and obtained permission from the BCC, the City shall not
 - » Close or barricade Maitland Avenue other than temporarily for road maintenance, repair, accidents or miscellaneous special events, or
 - » Vacate any portion of Maitland Avenue



Action Requested

Approval and Execution of the Following Documents:

- (1) Interlocal Agreement between Orange County and the City of Maitland regarding Transfer of Jurisdiction of Maitland Avenue from South Orlando Avenue to the Seminole County Line
- (2) the County Deed with authorization to have it recorded
- (3) the Assignment of Drainage Easements with authorization to have it recorded after it is executed by the City of Maitland
