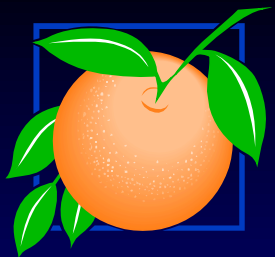




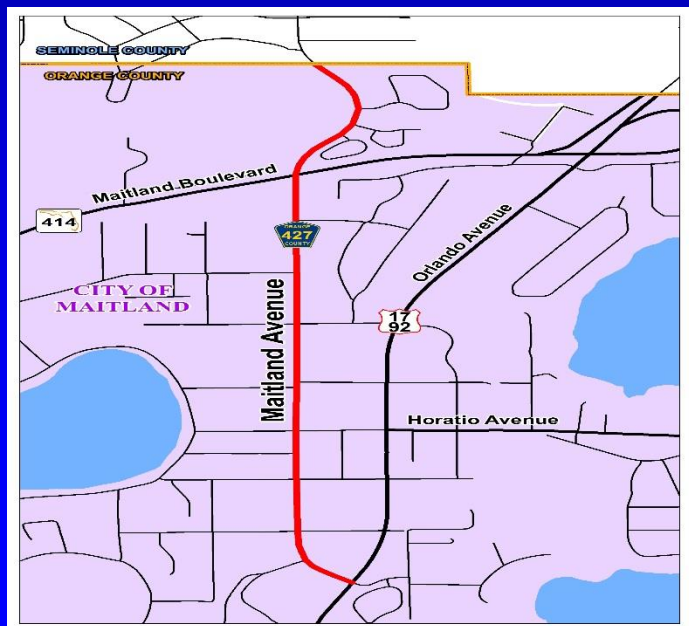

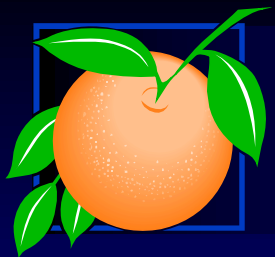

Maitland Avenue Jurisdictional Transfer

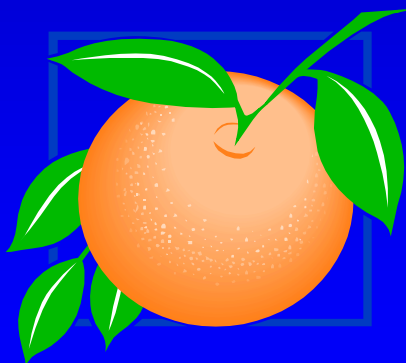
- Limits – S. Orlando Avenue to Seminole County Line
 - Length 1.4 Miles
 - Six Signals (22,500 AADT)
 - Lies Entirely Within City of Maitland

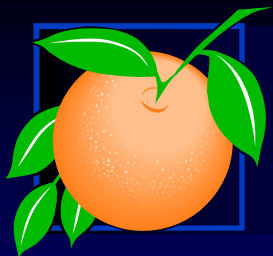




Maitland Avenue Jurisdictional Transfer

- History
 - Originally Part of State Highway System (SR 427)
 - State Transferred Ownership to Orange County in 1988
 - City Annexations (1990-1995)

- Agreement Background
 - Section 335.0415, Florida Statutes Public Roads May be Transferred Between Jurisdictions Only by Mutual Agreement of the Affected Governmental Entities

Dear Mr. Leike:

Orange County has prepared the Interlocal Agreement for the jurisdictional transfer of Maitland Avenue from S. Orlando Avenue to the Seminole County Line. The Agreement includes the transfer of the two retention areas and the supporting drainage easement that were acquired for the conveyance and collection of the drainage runoff from Maitland Avenue. In considering the City's request to modify the street language north of Hemlock Avenue, the County drafted language into the agreement that accommodates the City's redevelopment plans.

Please review the attached Interlocal Agreement and if the City has any comments or recommended changes, they should be returned to Orange County for consideration. If there are no changes to the Agreement, you can schedule two (2) original copies of the Agreement for approval by the City Council. Once approved by the City, please return the two (2) original signed copies of the agreement to they may be presented to the Orange County Board of Commissioners for approval.

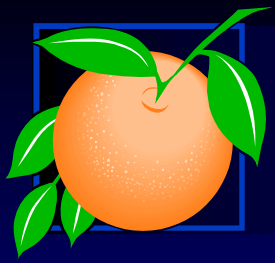

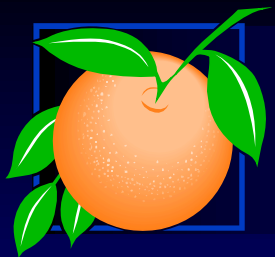

- **Agreement Background**
- **August 13, 2018 Maitland City Council Approved Transfer Agreement**
 - **Key Provision**
 - Unless having first applied for and obtained permission from the BCC, the City shall not
 - » Close or barricade Maitland Avenue other than temporarily for road maintenance, repair, accidents or miscellaneous special events, or
 - » Vacate any portion of Maitland Avenue



Maitland Avenue Jurisdictional Transfer

- **Action Requested**

Approval and Execution of the Following Documents:

- (1) Interlocal Agreement between Orange County and the City of Maitland regarding Transfer of Jurisdiction of Maitland Avenue from South Orlando Avenue to the Seminole County Line**
- (2) the County Deed with authorization to have it recorded**
- (3) the Assignment of Drainage Easements with authorization to have it recorded after it is executed by the City of Maitland**
