Parking in Residential Areas

Orange County staff routinely responds to various residential parking challenges, whether brought forward by members of a specific community or due to difficulties experienced by emergency responders who routinely navigate residential streets. During the Board meeting on February 6, 2018, Commissioner Thompson raised a number of on-going residential parking issues being managed by her aides. Brief discussion by the Board indicated that this problem is a county-wide issue, and the Mayor directed staff to bring back a work session on the topic.

The work session on October 2, 2018, will provide some recent examples of parking challenges, review existing county standards along with standards of other communities, and describe existing processes for establishing no parking zones.
