32	<u>years thereafter</u> ) for, the Orange County Regional History Center, beginning in Fiscal Year 2005-2006, initially in the amount up to
34	two million, five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000.00, the
36	"Maximum Funding Amount"), with annual increases of the Maximum Funding Amount in each subsequent year equal to the
38	lesser of 3% or the Consumer Price Index – All Urban Consumers, whichever is less, and subject to annual budget approval by the Board.
