### ORDINANCE NO. 2018-22

## AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO TAXATION IN ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING ARTICLE IV OF CHAPTER 25 OF THE ORANGE COUNTY CODE SECTION 25-140, TOURIST DEVELOPMENT PLAN; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

*Section 1.* Chapter 25, Article IV, Section 25-140 of the Orange County Code, is hereby amended, with such amendments being indicated below in Section 2 with the new text being <u>underlined</u> and the deleted text being struck through.

Section 2. Amendments to Section 25-140, Chapter 25, Article IV. Section 25-140,

Tourist Development Plan, Chapter 25, Article IV of the Orange County Code, is hereby amended by the revision or addition of the following priorities:

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Sec. 25-140. Tourist development plan.

## (16) Sixteenth priority. The sixteenth funding priority of the plan is to provide funding annually for reimbursement of actual operation and maintenance expenses of, and to allow capital spending and carryover (from Fiscal Year 2018-2019 and fiscal years thereafter) for, the Orange County Regional History Center, beginning in Fiscal Year 2005-2006, initially in the amount up to two million, five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000.00, the "Maximum Funding Amount"), with annual increases of the Maximum Funding Amount in each subsequent year equal to the lesser of 3% or the Consumer Price Index – All Urban Consumers, whichever is less, and subject to annual budget approval by the Board.

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(21) *Twenty-first Priority*. The twenty-first priority of the plan is to provide additional funding from legally available unallocated prior or current year revenues to the Orlando/Orange County Convention and Visitors Bureau d/b/a Visit Orlando for up to five million dollars per year for five years for increased marketing and promotion and for fiscal year 2018-19 to provide up to ten million dollars for increased marketing and promotion.

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(28) Twenty eighth priority. The twenty eighth priority of the plan is to provide funding in an amount not to exceed sixty million dollars (\$60,000,000) for project costs associated with the construction of improvements to the Camping World football stadium, as set forth in a funding agreement approved by the board of county commissioners.

(2829) Amendments to plan. The above and foregoing tourist development plan may not be amended except by ordinance enacted by an affirmative vote of a majority plus one (1) additional member of the board of county commissioners.

Section 3. Codification. The amendments to the Orange County Code set forth in

Section 2 shall be codified. No other sections or parts of sections of this ordinance shall be codified.

*Section 4. Effective date.* This ordinance shall become effective pursuant to general
