Subject: Award of Invitation for Bids Y18-790-JS, Orange County Barnett Park Site Lighting

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y18-790-JS, Orange County Barnett Park Site Lighting, to the low responsive and responsible M/WBE compliant bidder, Café Construction & Development, Inc., in the total contract award amount of \$309,000.

PROCUREMENT:

Work consists of the addition of pole mounted parking lot lighting to include concrete poles, power wiring, conduit, circuit breakers, and in-ground pull boxes for the following areas: soccer/football field north parking lot, baseball/softball parking areas, and tennis/basketball court parking areas. This work also includes the replacement of four light fixtures on existing poles at the tennis court. The project is located in District 6.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 1050-068-2100

APPROVALS:

The Capital Projects and Business Development Divisions concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Five bids were received in response to this Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. Café Construction & Development, Inc. is a certified M/WBE firm whose bid is within the 7% allowed by the solicitation for award to other than the low bidder in accordance with the County's M/WBE Ordinance, Section 17-324. The bid submitted from Café Construction & Development, Inc. is considered reasonable based on the engineer's estimate. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and Café Construction & Development, Inc. has been determined to be responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to Café Construction & Development, Inc.

PROJECT: Y18-790-JS / Orange County Barnett Park Site Lighting

The Business Development Division evaluated the 3 lowest bids of the 5 bids submitted for this project and found that the apparent low bidder Himes Electric Company, Inc. did not achieve good faith effort documentation and reported 0% MWBE participation in their bid.

The second low bid submitted by Orange County MWBE firm Café Construction & Development, Inc. is bidding as a prime. Therefore, Café Construction & Development, Inc. is required to self-perform no less than 51% of the contract per Sec. 17-321 in the MWBE Ordinance. In the event this requirement is not achieved, other MWBE's will have to be included to achieve the 25% MWBE goal. Café Construction & Development, Inc. reported self-performing only 29.14%. They reported 68.20% other MWBE participation in their bid and met the MWBE participation goal. The second low bid is within the 7% sliding scale range, of the low bidder, for contract awards from \$100,000 to \$500,000. The second low bid is only 1.64% greater than the low bid. Having met the MWBE participation goal and the sliding scale requirements, this bid may be awarded to the second low bidder. Please note the following certified MWBE participation:

The third low bid submitted by Orange County MWBE firm Comelco Inc. is bidding as a prime. Therefore, Comelco Inc. is required to self-perform no less than 51% of the contract per Sec. 17-321 in the MWBE Ordinance. In the event this requirement is not achieved, other MWBE's will have to be included to achieve the 25% MWBE goal. Comelco Inc. reported self-performing 0%. They reported 0% other MWBE participation in their bid and did not achieve good faith effort documentation.
