The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$10,000 from the FY 2019 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purposes:

Contributions:

Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) Lodge 93 "Cops and Kids" Program -\$5,000. The "Cops and Kids" program enables under-privileged and at-risk children the opportunity to go shopping with law enforcement officers at Christmas time to pick out gifts for themselves and their family members. These children are selected from referrals submitted by school resource officers; children advocate groups; and local ministries. This also gives the children the opportunity to interact with law enforcement officers in a positive manner.

The Holocaust Memorial Resource and Education Center of Florida -\$5,000. This organization is dedicated to combating anti-Semitism, racism, and prejudice, with the ultimate goal of developing a moral and just community through its extensive outreach of educational and cultural programs.

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$10,000 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide eligible contributions to Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) Lodge 93 "Cops and Kids" Program (\$5,000) and The Holocaust Memorial Resource and Education Center of Florida (\$5,000). PLEASE NOTE:

The Board voted to establish spending limits of 20% for this fund for contributions. At this point in the fiscal year, contributions represent 100% of the total expenditures; however, the restriction applies to total expenditures for the year, at yearend. The Sheriff's Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.
