- Purpose is to improve the lives of children, youth and families in Orange County
- Established September 19, 1988 as an ad hoc committee
- August 7, 1989 was made permanent by resolution 89-M-48
- January 28, 2007 the BCC adopted Resolution 97-M-03 which added an additional member and provided for the submission of reports on an annual basis.



- The BCC resolves to increase the membership by adding four members
 - Orange County superintendent of schools or his/her designee
 - A local school board member
 - The district administrator of Department of Children and Families
 - A judge handling juvenile cases in Orange County



- Allow for the creation of subcommittees
 - The advisory board may create subcommittees as necessary and engage members of the healthcare community for their experience and expertise
- Require joint meetings with the Citizens
 Review Panel (CRP), which provides funding to
 Human Service organizations in Orange
 County, a minimum of two times per year
