Rick Baldocchi, Avcon, Inc., Butte Planned Development / Land Use Plan (PD / LUP), Case # CDR-17-04-127; District 4 (Continued from September 18, 2018

Consideration: A PD substantial change to add a communication tower as a permitted use on Tract B. A waiver from Orange County Code is requested to reduce the distance separation requirement from 700 feet to 580 feet to the nearest residential building (memory care facility); pursuant to Orange County Code, Chapter 30, Article III, Section 30-89 and Orange County Code, Chapter 38, Article VIII, Division 1, Section 38-1207

Location: District 4; property generally located south of Lake Underhill Road, approximately 970 feet west of Rouse Road; Orange County, Florida (legal property description on file)

Based on all the relevant and competent evidence, letters, documentation, and testimony received at today's hearing, a motion was made by Commissioner Thompson, seconded by Commissioner Siplin, to deny the Butte PD Substantial Change request to permit a monopole communication tower at the Lake Underhill location because, first, the proposed tower would have a substantial adverse aesthetic visual impact on single family homes to the southeast, and: second, the proposed tower would have a substantial adverse economic impact by diminishing the property values of those homes and reducing their marketability. The motion carried by the following vote:
