Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y19-133-MV, Street Sweeping Services for EPD Lake Management, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, USA Services of Florida, Inc., in the estimated annual contract amount of \$358,800. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for four additional 1-year terms.

PROCUREMENT:

Street sweeping removes sediment and debris from roadways in order to minimize stormwater pollution in local surface waters.
