

SUBJECT: November 13, 2018 – Consent Item

Since 1977, Orange County has partnered with other fire agencies to jointly sponsor and participate in firefighting, emergency medical, and emergency management training. In 2005, this partnership was formalized in an Interlocal Agreement establishing the Central Florida Fire Consortium. Today, the Consortium is comprised of multiple county and city fire agencies, and its training facility located at 2966 W. Oakridge Road, Orlando, FL 32809.

Under the terms of the agreement, participants pay an annual fee for use of the training facility with unique capabilities, including a "Burn Building," a four-story training tower, and liquid petroleum gas fire training. The Consortium also offers various training programs at a reduced rate. The membership cost for Orange County for FY 2018-2019 is \$136,012.20.
