WHEREAS, pursuant to procedures adopted by the Board of County Commissioners, a petition was filed with the Board to vacate that certain **portion of a 60 foot wide right-of-way containing approximately 1,327 square feet** in Orange County, Florida, as described in attachment.

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners on **October 30, 2018**, was published in the **Orlando Sentinel**, a newspaper of general circulation in Orange County, Florida, one time at least two weeks prior to the date for the hearing; and




