City of Orlando Ordinance No. 2018-51 entitled: An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida, annexing to the corporate limits of the City certain land generally located south of Rayburn Street, east of Boggy Creek Road, and north of Tradeport Drive, and comprised of 9.5 acres of land, more or less; and amending the City's boundary description: amending the City's adopted Growth Management Plan to designate the property as industrial and industrial/resource protection on the City's official Future Land Use Maps; designating the property as the Planned Development Zoning District, within the Air Commerce Park Planned Development, on the City's official zoning maps; amending the Air Commerce Park Planned Development to include the property in the legal description and the development plan; providing for amendment of the City's official Future Land Use and Zoning Maps; providing for severability, correction of scrivener's errors, permit disclaimer and an effective date.
