AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF COUNTY BUSINESS AT THE BRANCH OFFICE OF THE ORANGE COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR AT 301 SOUTH ROSALIND AVENUE, ORLANDO, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Orange County Tax Collector has established a branch office at 301 South Rosalind Avenue, Orlando, Florida, 32801; and

WHEREAS, Article 8, Section 1(k), of the Florida Constitution provides, in part: "In every county there shall be a county seat at which shall be located the principal offices and permanent records of all county officers ... Branch offices for the conduct of county business may be established elsewhere in the county by resolution of the governing body of the county in the manner prescribed by law"; and

WHEREAS, Subsection 197.332(2), Florida Statutes (2018), provides, in part: "A county tax collector may establish one or more branch offices by acquiring title to real property or by lease agreement. The tax collector may hire staff and equip such branch offices to conduct state business, or, if authorized to do so by resolution of the county governing body, conduct county business pursuant to s. 1(k), Art. VIII of the State Constitution"; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that pursuant to Article 8, Section 1(k), of the Florida Constitution and Subsection 197.332(2), Florida Statutes (2018), authorizing the Orange County Tax Collector to conduct county business at such aforementioned branch office is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated by reference into the body of this Resolution and such recitals are adopted as findings of fact.

2. Pursuant to Article 8, Section 1(k), of the Florida Constitution and Subsection 197.332(2), Florida Statutes (2018), County hereby authorizes the Orange County Tax Collector to conduct county business from its branch office at 301 South Rosalind Avenue, Orlando, Florida, 32801.

3. This Resolution shall not be construed to change the county seat of Orange County from the City of Orlando.

4. The Board hereby directs that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded forthwith to the Orange County Tax Collector.

5. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Board.
