Release of All Property Damage Claims with Nationwide, April 26, 2017 - Duke Energy and HNC Properties, LLC

Orange County Utilities (OCU) periodically incurs third party underground line damage through no fault of its own. In an attempt to improve collections of these third party damage claims, OCU will soon partner with the Risk Management Division (RM) to handle the processing, release, and collection of future third party damage claims. Under this partnership, RM will use its expertise and experience related to third party claims and will sign releases for payment of claims under its existing authority as delegated by the Board.

Presently, three pending releases totaling \$53,430.38 require Board approval. Nationwide, one of three pending releases, has provided a release in the amount of \$10,953.99 for damages incurred to OCU's infrastructure by Duke Energy and its subcontractor, HNC Property LLC, on April 26, 2017.

The County Attorney's Office and RM staff reviewed this release of all property damage claims from Nationwide and finds it legally sufficient. OCU staff recommends approval.
