Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for two additional 1-year terms.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this contract is to select two firms for negotiation of a contract to provide and construction materials testing for capital continuing professional geotechnical improvement construction projects and miscellaneous maintenance and repair projects at the Convention Center.

The Consultants will perform geotechnical investigation and/or construction material testing for the construction involving buildings or culverts, asphalt, roadways, and similar improvements.
